## **Road Improvement Bond Proposal**

To bring all of the Township of Summit roads back to an optimal condition will cost approximately \$31 million. The Jackson County Department of Transportation will provide a grant to cover 30% of the total costs for these road improvements. The Road Improvement Bond Proposal on the August 8<sup>th</sup> ballot will allow the remaining 70% of funding to come from a millage spread over 16 years. A millage is a tax based on property value. In this case, 2.83 mills would equal \$2.83 per \$1,000 of taxable property value. If the bond is approved, work will start in 2017 with all roads completed by 2020.
