March 23, 2017 – The Summit Township Board of Trustees has approved a rate increase for water and sewer service effective April 1, 2017. Water service rates have not increased since 1998 and sewer service rates have not increased since 2010.

Earlier this year the Township Board engaged the services of Stantec Consulting to conduct a rate study of the water and sewer service provided to residents and commercial customers. As a result of this study, the Board approved a 5% per year increase for water service and a 2 1/4 % per year increase for sewer service for each of the next 5 years.

A typical residential water service customer with a 3/4 inch service will see their rate increase by 60 cents per month. The new quarterly bill will be \$33.30.

A typical residential sewer service customer will see their rate increase by 60 cents per month. The new quarterly bill will be \$70.80.

A typical residential water (3/4 inch service) and sewer service customer (the vast majority of residential customers) will see their rates increase by \$1.20 per month. The new quarterly bill will be \$104.10.

Residential customers with a 1 inch water service and/or sewer service and commercial water and sewer customers will see proportional increases. Customers who want to know information regarding their specific service may contact the Department of Public Works (DPW) at (517) 788-4113, extension 224.
